



**No Child Left Behind  
Public School Choice Option and Supplemental Educational Services (SES)  
Frequently Asked Questions**

**What choices do I have for my child?**

As a parent you can choose for your child to attend one of the schools listed as CHOICE, or you can choose for your child to remain in their current school and receive supplemental educational services (SES).

**What are Supplemental Educational Services (SES)?**

The term Supplemental Educational Services refers to tutoring services in reading and/or math. This extra help is provided after school, before school, or on weekends by private tutoring agencies at no cost to the parent. Applications for SES will be sent home with students who are attending a program improvement school in the beginning of September.

**Will all applications for CHOICE and SES be approved?**

It is possible. There is a set amount of money for these programs. If there is not enough money to serve all the students who apply, priority will be given to the lowest performing eligible students.

**When can my child start at the school I have chosen?**

If you choose for your child to attend one of the available CHOICE schools offered by Twin Rivers Unified School District (TRUSD) your child will need to remain at their home school until the application process is complete and the test scores are released (after the first week of September). We will inform you as soon as the transfer can take place.

**Is transportation provided to the CHOICE school I have chosen for my child?**

Transportation will be provided for your child to attend the school you have chosen from the TRUSD CHOICE options while it remains a non-program improvement school.

**Can my child transfer to another school under NCLB Choice and also get SES?**

No. You can choose only one option.

**Can I change my mind later?**

The deadline for making your decision on CHOICE is August 20, 2010.
