This evening we received notice from USDA regarding the recall of raw beef products by Huntington Meats of Montebello California.

The beef in question may have been sold to commercial processors who may have sold finished products to schools.

In this notice, USDA issued a statement that no commodity products are thought to be involved in this recall. With the exception of four items, all beef products served in our schools come from non-commercial commodity processors.

Of the four items in question, one item has already been cleared as not containing beef from Huntington Meats. The other three products will be excluded from our menus until their origin can be verified.

Please be assured that the wellbeing and safety of your children is our top priority. We will not serve any food item that is question of being safe for consumption. For more information, please visit the USDA food safety website at:
