## Meal Price Increase

In December of 2010 President Obama signed The Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-296) making many changes to Child Nutrition Programs.

One of the provisions in this act, *"Equity in School Lunch Pricing in the National School Lunch Program"*, states that school districts will be required to increase the cost of their paid lunch prices until the average weighted revenue per lunch matches the federal reimbursement rate, which is adjusted for inflation every year. Using a tool designed to calculate weighted price increases, our new pricing schedule is shown below:

### New pricing for the 2014/2015 school year:

<b>Elementary PK-6 lunch</b>	<b>\$2.25</b>
<b>Elementary 7-8 grade lunch</b>	<b>\$2.50</b>
<b>High School and Middle School lunch</b>	<b>\$3.00</b>

**Adult Lunch (incl. tax) \$3.80**

(Adult meals must be priced at least \$0.50 higher than the full price charged to students and must be charged sales tax)

Breakfast Prices did not change:

<b>Elementary PK-6 breakfast</b>	<b>\$1.00</b>
<b>Elementary 7-8 breakfast</b>	<b>\$1.00</b>
<b>High School and Middle School breakfast</b>	<b>\$1.25</b>

**Adult Breakfast (incl. tax) \$2.00**

We understand the increased hardship this may cause our families. To help compensate for the required price increase, our salad bar programs will continue to expand, barbecued foods will be offered at four of our High Schools and new menu items will be added.
