

# HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SESSION 2010

## June 14 through July 22, 2010

Classes start promptly at 8:30 a.m. and conclude at 2:00 p.m. Classes will be held Monday through Thursday. There will be no summer school held on Monday, July 5<sup>th</sup>.  
Classes are offered for remediation only.

Home School of attendance: Grant HS students will attend Grant HS, West Campus

Keema, Pacific and Vista Nueva students will attend summer school at their home school of attendance

### REGISTRATION: (Priority is given to 12<sup>th</sup> grade students)

Registration will be held at Winona Center, 3222 Winona Way, North Highlands. (see map on reverse)

Registration dates and times are:

**12<sup>th</sup> Grade Students: Monday, June 7, 2010: 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

**11<sup>th</sup> Grade Students: Tuesday, June 8, 2010: 7:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.**

You must bring a COMPLETED registration form to register.

**THERE WILL BE NO REGISTRATION AFTER THE ABOVE DATES TO ATTEND SUMMER SCHOOL. NO REGISTRATION WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE SUMMER SCHOOL SITES.**

**10<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:** If space is available after 12<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students have registered, 10<sup>th</sup> grade students needing summer school will be offered classes on a lottery basis. Counselors will submit student needs to the district office. 10<sup>th</sup> grade students selected through the lottery will be contacted by telephone no later than Thursday, June 10<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure you provide your counselor with 2 valid phone numbers.

**9<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:** If space is available after 12<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students have registered, 9<sup>th</sup> grade students needing summer school will be offered classes on a lottery basis. Counselors will submit student needs to the district office. 9<sup>th</sup> grade students selected through the lottery will be contacted by telephone no later than Thursday, June 10<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure you provide your counselor with 2 valid phone numbers.

*Classes are limited and priority will be given to upper classman. Classes are also offered based on enrollment and availability of staff.*

### ATTENDANCE POLICIES

**Attendance is critical!** Students who do not attend the first day will be considered "no-show" and lose their enrollment. Only one (1) absence is permitted per session. Students who are absent a second day will be dropped from summer school. In the summer school program, there are no excused absences. Punctuality is very important as two (2) *tardies equal one absence.*

### WITHDRAW FROM SUMMER SCHOOL

Students may withdraw from summer school without penalty **within the first three (3) days of summer school. STUDENTS WHO WITHDRAW AFTER THE FIRST WEEK WILL WITHDRAW WITH A GRADE OF "F".**

### TRANSPORTATION

No transportation will be provided.

### SUMMER SCHOOL RULES

Student participation in summer school is not required by law in the same way it is during the regular school year. If behavior and attendance rules are broken during the summer term, the summer school principal can dismiss a student from summer school immediately. A letter will be attached to all summer school applications stating the summer school rules. By signing the registration form, you acknowledge that students will comply with all stated summer school rules and understand that if any rules are violated a student will be dismissed from the summer school program.
