## 2012-2013 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

**Beginning Tuesday, January 10, 2012, schools in the Twin Rivers Unified School District (TRUSD) will be accepting kindergarten registration for the 2012-2013 school year.**

To enter kindergarten, a child must meet the following requirements for admission as established by the Education Code of the State of California, the State Board of Education and the administrative rules and regulations established by the TRUSD:

- PROOF OF RESIDENCY.** Acceptable documents are utility bills or payment receipts; rental or lease agreements; property tax receipts; pay stubs; voter registration; correspondence from a government agency; or declaration of residency executed by the parent/guardian.
- PROOF OF AGE.<sup>1</sup>** Acceptable documents are a birth certificate, baptismal certificate, passport, immigration certificate, Bible record, or when none of these documents are available, an affidavit from the parent/guardian. A child turning **five (5) years of age on or before November 1, 2012** will enter kindergarten.
- PROOF OF REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS<sup>1</sup>, DENTAL CHECKUP & HEALTH EXAM.** Children must have a physical exam and dental checkup their first year of school (forms are included in the registration packet). Please review your child's shot record with your physician at the time of the health exam to ensure that your child has received all required immunizations as listed below.

Vaccine	Required Immunizations
Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis (DTaP)	<u>Five</u> (5) doses at any age, but four (4) doses if the last dose was after fourth birthday
Polio	<u>Four</u> (4) doses at any age, but three (3) doses if the last dose was after fourth birthday
Hepatitis B	<u>Three</u> (3) doses. Children who have received at least one dose of Hepatitis B vaccine may enter kindergarten on the condition that they receive the remaining required doses as follows: <input type="checkbox"/> 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose – One to two months after 1 <sup>st</sup> dose <input type="checkbox"/> 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose – Children under age 18 months to 6 years (two to six months after 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose) <input type="checkbox"/> 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose – Children age 18 months to 6 years (two to six months after 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose)
Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR)	<u>Two</u> (2) doses required, both after the age of one (1). Children 4½ - 5 years old who have just received their first dose of MMR may enter kindergarten on the condition that they receive a second dose 1-3 months later
Varicella	<u>One</u> (1) dose (2 doses recommended between 4-6 years of age) or documentation of disease

Thank you in advance for your cooperation in obtaining the required documents. We look forward to working with your family to ensure a successful school year for your child.
